

ORDER IMPOSING INJUNCTION FOR CONTEMPT OF COURT AND VIOLATION OF 11 U.S.C. § 110

Upon consideration of the United States Trustee's Motion for Injunction for Contempt of Court and Violation of 11 U.S.C. § 110 (the "Motion for Injunction"), a hearing having been conducted on the Motion for Injunction on August 20, 2012, good and sufficient notice of both the Motion for Injunction and the hearing having been duly provided, and Eddie C. Wilson ("Wilson") having not appeared at the hearing, finding good caused stated in the Motion for Injunction, that Wilson is a bankruptcy petition preparer as that term is defined by 11 U.S.C. § 110, that Wilson failed to file a Declaration and Signature of Non-Attorney Bankruptcy Petition Preparer or a Disclosure of Compensation of Bankruptcy Petition Preparer as required by Section 110(h), that Wilson is in contempt of this Court's Order Directing Debtor(s)' Bankruptcy Petition

Preparer to Refund All Fees (Doc. 21) and this Court's Order that Bankruptcy Petition

Preparer Show Cause for Failure to Comply with Court Order to Refund Fees (Doc. 26),

it is, therefore, by the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland,

ORDERED that the United States Trustee's Motion for Injunction for Contempt

of Court and Violations of 11 U.S.C. § 110 be, and hereby is, GRANTED; and it is

further

ORDERED that, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 110(j)(3), Eddie C. Wilson be, and

hereby is, permanently enjoined from acting as a bankruptcy petition preparer in any

jurisdiction in the United States, subject to further order of this Court; and it is further

ORDERED that, within five (5) business days after the entry of this Order, the

United States Trustee shall serve a copy of this Order on Wilson and file a certificate of

service of same with this Court.
