CONSENT ORDER FOR DETERMINATION OF
NON-DISCHARGEABILITY OF DEBT
AND FOR JUDGMENT

Upon consideration of the Complaint for Determination of Non-Dischargeability of Debt filed by FIDELITY AND DEPOSIT COMPANY OF MARYLAND and the Consent thereto by the defendant, it is this 10th day of November, 1988,

ORDERED, that the claim of FIDELITY AND DEPOSIT COMPANY OF MARYLAND be, and the same is hereby determined to be non-dischargeable;

ORDERED, that judgment be, and the same is hereby entered in favor of FIDELITY AND DEPOSIT COMPANY OF MARYLAND against the defendant, IRIS PRESTON HAZZARD in the amount of \$15,000.00 upon the condition that the defendant pay the sum of \$50.00 per month starting December 15, 1988 and each month thereafter until the

said sum is paid in full.

Upon the failure of the defendant to make payments as promised, the plaintiff, if said payments are 30 days late, moves to set aside the \$15,000.00 judgment and moves for judgment in the sum of \$247,756.02, with credit for payments made, to be entered against the defendant.
