

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER MODIFYING
LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULE 5001-2(b)**

WHEREAS the remaining provisions of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 are effective on October 17, 2005, and the possibility exists for a number of citizens to seek protection under the existing law prior to this effective date, the Court is concerned about the ease of filing during non-business days prior to October 17, 2005.

Accordingly, it is


ORDERED, that Local Bankruptcy Rule 5001-2(b) is temporarily amended to allow the night box in the Garmatz Federal Courthouse in Baltimore to remain open for filings from 4:00 p.m. Friday, October 14, 2005, until 12 midnight, October 16, 2005.




