

**ORDER DIRECTING SERVICE OF HARD COPY OF PETITION,  
STATEMENT AND SCHEDULES ON TRUSTEE**

The Court finds that there is cause to continue interim procedures to facilitate the transition from a system based on paper to an electronic environment under the Case Management/Electronic Case Filing system (CM/ECF).

**WHEREFORE**, in every case filed in this Court under Chapter 7 and 13 before October 1, 2003, the debtor shall serve a paper copy of the petition, statements, schedules (and plan, if applicable) on the trustee assigned to the case. Service shall be accomplished immediately upon receipt of notification of the name of the trustee assigned to the case or upon filing of the papers.
