**WHEREAS**, the Court has determined that the Local Rules of this Court adopted effective May 1, 2007 require further revisions; and

**WHEREAS**, committees of the Bench and Bar of this Court have recommended that the Local Bankruptcy Rules of this Court be revised and adopted as herein ordered;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby ORDERED, this 15<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2007, by the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland, that effective the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November, 2007, the following Local Bankruptcy Rules shall be effective as to all proceedings pending in this Court on that date insofar as is just and practicable, and shall govern all proceedings in bankruptcy cases thereafter commenced in this Court. These Rules shall be cited as “MD LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES.”

It is further ORDERED, that the Administrative Orders listed below are rendered inactive as their provisions have either been incorporated into these Local Bankruptcy Rules or are no longer necessary due to changes in the Title 11 of the United States Code or federal rules:
