**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 26-01 EXTENDING TEMPORARY  
CLOSING OF BANKRUPTCY INTAKE COUNTERS FROM 1 PM TO 2 PM**

The Clerk's Office for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland is currently experiencing staffing issues which threaten to impact the exemplary service provided daily by the Clerk's Office. To ensure that the Clerk's Office is able to continue provide exemplary service, the Court determines that it is necessary on a temporary basis to continue to modify the public intake counter hours in both divisions, as first addressed in Administrative Order 25-03. Therefore, it is, by the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland,

ORDERED that the public intake counters for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland, in both Baltimore and Greenbelt, will continue to close from 1 pm to 2 pm, Monday through Friday; and it is further

ORDERED that pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 5001(c) and Local Bankruptcy Rule 5001-2(a), the Clerk's Office will otherwise remain open during this time; and it is further

ORDERED that this Administrative Order is effective through April 30, 2026, subject to additional extension or modification by the Court.
