ORDERED, that the defendant's indebtedness to the plaintiff based upon the promissory note dated May 12, 1987, be and it hereby is a nondischargeable debt; and it is further

ORDERED, that judgment be and it hereby is entered in favor of the plaintiff, The Riggs National Bank of Washington, D.C., and against the defendant, Claudette Stockman, in the amount of \$2,699.60 plus interest at the rate of 13% per annum from April 30, 1988 ^{to date,} together with a reasonable attorney's fee of 15%, amounting to \$404.94, and Court costs.
