CONSENT ORDER

Upon consideration of Plaintiff's Complaint To Determine Dischargeability Of Debt and the consent of the parties as is evidenced by the signature of Plaintiff's counsel and the signature of the Defendant and Defendant's counsel attached hereto, it is on this 30th day of January, 1990, by the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland,


ORDERED, that the loan dated July 11, 1989, executed by the Defendant, Helen E. Pittman, in favor of the Plaintiff, Citizens National Bank, in the principal amount of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) be and is hereby declared non-dischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. 523(a)(2)(B), and it is further,

ORDERED, that judgment be and hereby is entered in favor of the Plaintiff, Citizens National Bank, and against the Defendant, Helen E. Pittman, in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars


(\$2,000.00) plus accrued interest in the amount of \$166.60 through December 27, 1989, plus interest at the contract rate of 18% per annum thereafter until the debt is paid in full, plus attorney's fees in the amount of \$168.75 and court costs, and it is further,

ORDERED, that the Plaintiff shall not execute on said judgment as long as the Defendant, Helen E. Pittman, causes payments to be made to Citizens National Bank in the amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month commencing February 10, 1990, and on the 10th day of each and every month thereafter until the judgment debt is paid in full. In the event Defendant fails to make any of the aforesaid payments in a timely manner, Plaintiff, upon affidavit to the Court that the Defendant has failed to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, shall be entitled to execute on the judgment without further order of Court.
