ORDER HOLDING HOWARD M. HENESON IN CONTEMPT.
ORDERING TURNOVER OF FUNDS AND ENTERING JUDGMENT

WHEREAS, this Court entered an Order dated May 28, 1991 directing Howard M. Heneson, Counsel to the Debtors, to show cause within 21 days why he ought not be held in contempt of this court for distributing proceeds to his clients, without authority of this Court, from various sales of estate property to which adverse claims asserted by other parties were pending, and for having failed to abide the orders and directives of this court requiring him to submit an accounting of all sales proceeds; and

WHEREAS, Howard M. Heneson was also directed to show cause within 21 days why he should not be required to stand liable for the payment of funds in the approximate amount of \$47,500 which he wrongfully and without authority disbursed to the Debtors; and

WHEREAS, upon consideration of the Answer to Order to Show Cause and any responses thereto, it is this 2nd day of June, 1992, by the US Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland hereby:

ORDERED, that Howard M. Heneson is found and adjudged to be in contempt of court; and

Howard M. Heneson is ordered to turnover \$47,437.70 to counsel for the Resolution Trust Corporation, as successor in interest to Baltimore Federal Financial, of which \$4,820.63 shall be paid by RTC to Hunter Associates pursuant to a settlement of the Adversary Proceeding between those parties; and

Judgment is hereby entered in favor of the Resolution Trust Corporation, as successor in interest to Baltimore Federal Financial and Hunter Association against Howard M. Heneson in the amount of \$47,437.70.
