ORDERED, that Howard M. Heneson is found and adjudged to be in concempt of court; and

Howard M. Heneson is ordered to turnover \$47,437.70 to counsel for the Resolution Trust Corporation, as successor in interest to Baltimore Federal Financial, of which \$4,820.63 shall be paid by RTC to Hunter Associates pursuant to a settlement of the Adversary Proceeding between those parties; and

Judgment is hereby entered in favor of the Resolution Trust Corporation, as successor in interest to Baltimore Federal Financial and Hunter Association against Howard M. Heneson in the amount of \$47,437.70.
