Upon consideration of the Complaint Objecting to Discharge and to Determine Nondischargeability of Debt ("Complaint") filed by John Deere Company ("Deere"), and upon the consent of the parties, it is this 10th day of January, 1992, by the Court,


ORDERED, that the obligations and debt of Shelley Jene Garretson to Deere are nondischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. 523(a)(6) in the amount of Ten Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars and Thirty-Eight Cents (\$10,589.38); and it is further

ORDERED, that judgment be entered in favor of Deere against Garretson in the amount of Ten Thousand Five Hundred

Eighty-Nine Dollars and Thirty-Eight Cents (\$10,589.38) plus  
<sup>Court Costs</sup> interest and costs; and it is further

ORDERED, that Counts Two through Four of the Complaint are dismissed, with prejudice; and it is further

ORDERED, that the provisions of this Consent Judgment and Order shall survive any order of discharge of the Debtor entered into in this bankruptcy proceeding.




