ORDER FOR CONSENT JUDGMENT

Upon consideration of the Stipulation of the Plaintiff and the
Defendant For Entry of Consent Judgment, ^{and upon the Trustee's Consent} it is

ORDERED, that Judgment in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars
(\$500.00) be entered in favor of SSA Baltimore Federal Credit Union,
the Plaintiff, and against Gloria Marie Mitchell, the Defendant, and
it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that Defendant will make payments to Plaintiff
in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per month beginning on

December 1, 1983, and continuing on such date monthly thereafter until the judgment is paid in full, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, in the event Defendant misses any such payment and does not cure same within ten (10) days, Defendant shall be indebted unto Plaintiff for an additional sum of Nine Hundred Seventy-nine Dollars and Seventy-five Cents (\$979.75).
