Further ORDERED, that judgment by default be entered in favor of the Plaintiff, Michael G. Rinn, Trustee and against the Defendant Woody Weems a/k/a Edmund Weems in the amount of

\$16,257.67 together with post-judgment interest, and cost of these proceedings pursuant to the provisions of 11 U.S.C. §550(a)(1).
