Changes to Bankruptcy Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule (28 U.S.C. § 1930)

Effective December 1, 2020, select fees on the Bankruptcy Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule will increase (*see attached*).

The Administrative Fee - Item No. 8 on the Attachment - details the fee increases applicable to petitions filed under each chapter of bankruptcy. The Administrative Fee is a portion of the total fee for filing a petition; thus, the total filing fee will increase.

For example:

- The Administrative Fee for filing a petition under Chapter 7, 12 or 13 is increasing by \$3, from \$75 to \$78, which will result in the following total filing fee increases:
 - Chapter 7 from \$335 to \$338;
 - Chapter 12 from \$275 to \$278; and
 - Chapter 13 from \$310 to \$313.
- The Administrative Fee for filing a petition under Chapter 11 is increasing by \$21, from \$550 to \$571, which will result in a total filing fee increase from \$1,717 to \$1,738.
