ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 20-14
RESCINDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS 20-04 AND 20-08

The Court has announced its progression into Phase Two of its recovery plan, effective June 22, 2020. As the Court enters Phase Two, and as the public health guidance surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic has evolved, some of the orders previously entered to respond to the disease are no longer necessary.

Therefore, it is, by the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland, hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. Administrative Order 20-04 temporarily suspending in-court proceedings in the Greenbelt Courthouse is RESCINDED; and
2. Administrative Order 20-08 temporarily suspending the requirement to deliver paper courtesy copies to the Bankruptcy Clerk’s Office or to Chambers of the presiding judge is RESCINDED.
