**RESCINDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 20-10**

Administrative Order 20-10, addressing modification of confirmed plans pursuant to the CARES Act and expedited treatment of Chapter 13 motions to suspend plan payments or to vacate wage orders, was adopted in response to exigent circumstances brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic. The Court has considered the continued need for Administrative Order 20-10 in light of the current pandemic environment, and has determined, after consultation, that the order is no longer necessary.

Therefore, it is, by the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland, hereby:
